PreSchool Group Gatherings

Children's Liturgy

When & Where?

Children's Liturgy is generally held during the 9am Mass at St Bede's Church and the 10:30am Mass at St Anne's Church each Sunday of the school term with the exception of public holidays and the weekends when family and other special Masses are scheduled.

The children are invited to meet in a separate area with a leader after the start of Mass and return to the Mass after the Prayers of the Faithful.

Parents are not required but welcome to attend. Preschoolers **must** be accompanied by a guardian.



Family Mass

The Family Mass offers children the opportunity to be involved in the regular Sunday liturgy.

Classes from the school are rostered on for Masses throughout the year and are involved in the Liturgy in a number of ways. At St Anne's Family Masses usually occur on Sundays at 10.30am and at St Bede's, Sundays at 11am.

All Family Masses are published beforehand in the Parish and school newsletters.



Morning Tea / Supper

Hospitality is available in the Hall at St Anne's or the Jarrow Room at St Bede's after each Family Mass and is provided and hosted by the families of the children from the rostered class.
