Pre-Sacramental Program for Parish Children not in a Catholic School

Enrolments for the Pre-Sacramental Program for Parish children not in a Catholic school **open on Tuesday 22 October 2024.**

Children to be enrolled must be parishioners of either of the Affiliated Parishes of Balwyn North Kew East or Greythorn. They will need to complete the Pre-Sacramental Program before enrolling in Reconciliation, First Communion and Confirmation. Children must be in Grade 3 or above.

The classes will be held for four Saturdays at 4pm at St Anne’s Church, followed by attendance at 5pm Mass with their families. **Classes will be on 8, 15, 22 February and 1 March 2025.**

Enrolment forms are available from the parish office, as well as the parish websites, and **enrolments close on Monday 16 December 2024.** Children who complete the Pre-Sacramental Program will continue on to the First Reconciliation Program in fourth term.

Sale of goods from anti-trafficking sewing centre, Kawthaung, Myanmar

The Sisters of Our Lady of the Missions established the Anti-Trafficking Sewing Centre at Kawthaung, Myanmar with the support of St Bede’s Parish in 2010. The sewing project offers a six-month basic sewing course and when the young women have graduated they are employed locally, establish their own sewing business or return to the workroom where they are paid a salary for the goods they make. The income they earn supports their families and prevents them from becoming victims of human trafficking. **At St Anne’s and St Bede’s Masses over this weekend there will be a sale of these goods made by the women in Myanmar.** Myanmar continues to experience many challenges, particularly with the military coup, however the sewing workroom is also a safe work environment for these young women and contributes to their sustainability. All funds from the sale of these goods go directly to the women. *We pray for the people of Myanmar at this difficult time.*
