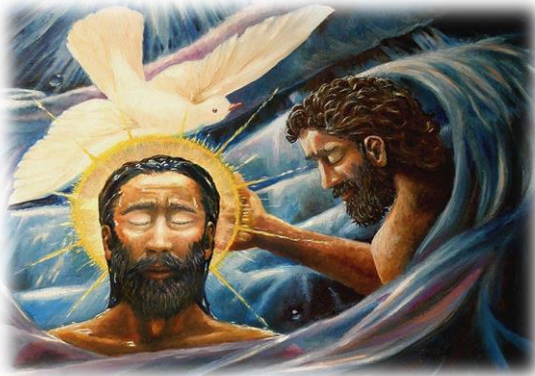

**COVIDSAFE
REGISTRATION**

We are no longer using Trybooking for pre-booking, as numbers do not require people to pre-book.

We are using the State Government QR Code service to register all Mass attendees. This allows quick contact tracing in the event it is necessary.

Once you have downloaded the QR app, there is secure communication of your details to the database. Any entry is automatically deleted after 28 days.

Once you have saved your details on the app, you only need to open and scan the QR Code whenever you come to the church.

If you do not have a mobile phone, or cannot download the app, there will be someone available to help you book in.
